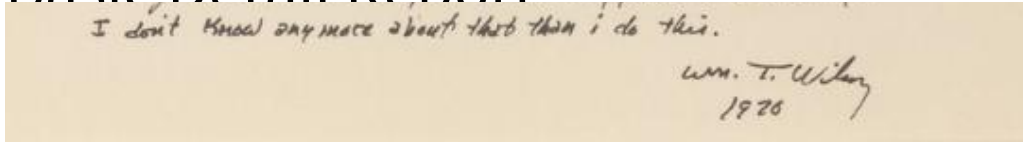


Initial Break Through
